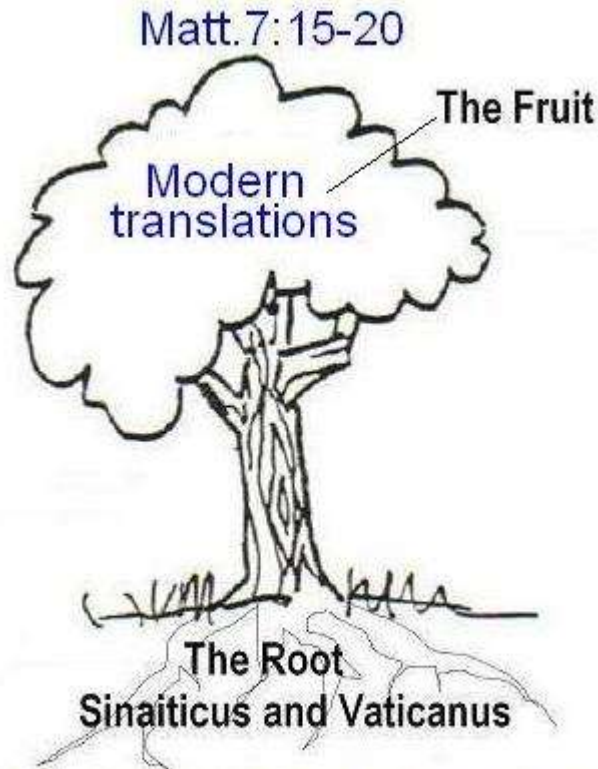
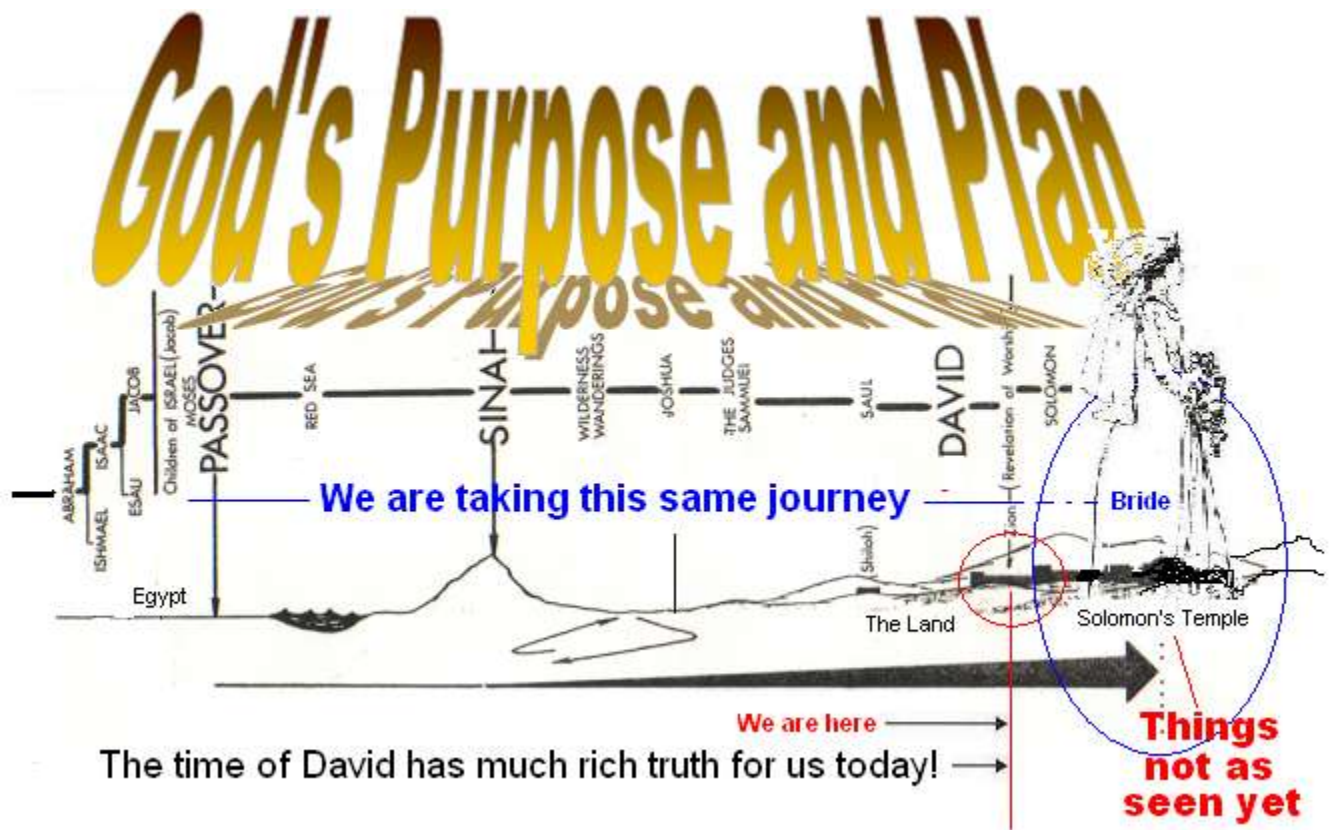


Phase 1 - [Why I use the King James Bible](#)

It is the washing of water BY THE WORD that will prepare the "last" Eve (the Church) to be presented as a "glorious" bride "not having spot, or wrinkle, or any such thing; but it should be holy and without blemish." This is why the serpent (the Devil, Satan, Lucifer) is still saying, "...Yea, hath God said..." [provoking the Church into changing God's Word as he did with Eve](#) in the garden. (Gen.2:16; 3:1-5, 2 Cor.11:1-3) His strategy is to corrupt God's Word and destroy our preparation as Christ's Bride. Beginning in 1881 AD. with the Revised Version, the Church has been "beguiled" (2Cor.11:3) into changing God's Word, just as the serpent did to Eve. This has continued to "vex" the Church with every modern translation after the King James. (**Compare all their doubtful footnotes**) This study identifies the "root" cause.



This is where the "footnotes" come from for every modern translation from the Revised Version until our present time.



Phase 2 - God's Purpose and Plan

This is a study using the children of Israel leaving Egypt and possessing the Land, as an "ensample"

(Greek. type) of the journey that God has, is presently, and is yet to take the Church, (the Bride of Christ).

(Gen.12:1; 15:13-21, Exod.12:1-15 / 1 Cor.5:7-8)

Deut.12:1-12, 1Chron.17:1-15; 22:1-19, 2 Chron.5:1-14 / Eph.2:20-22,

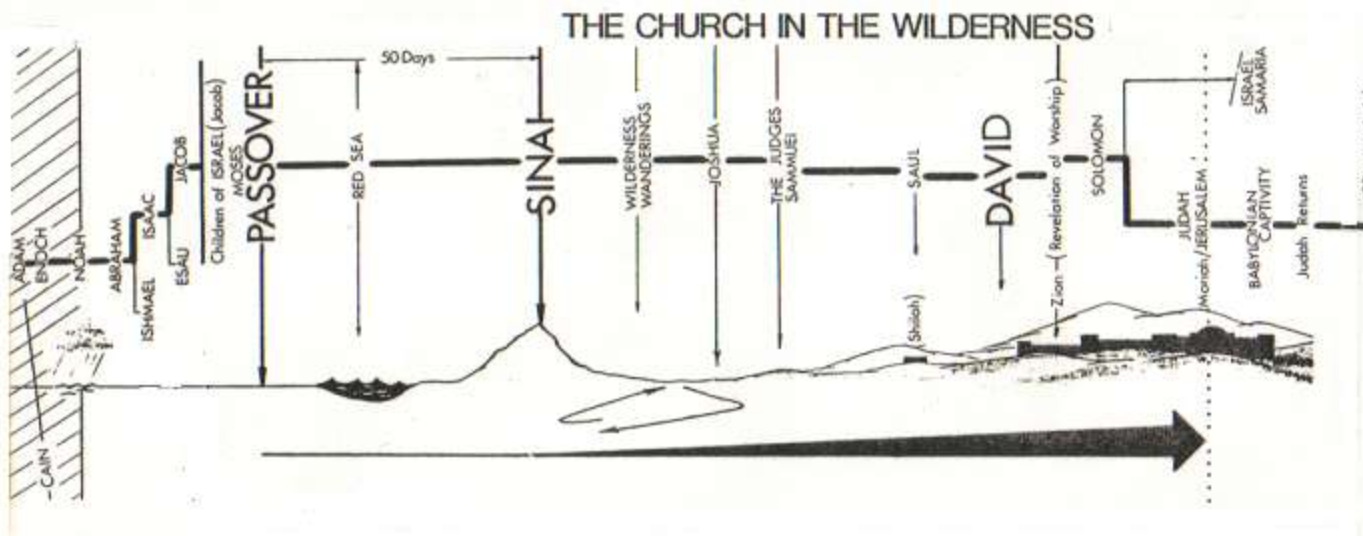
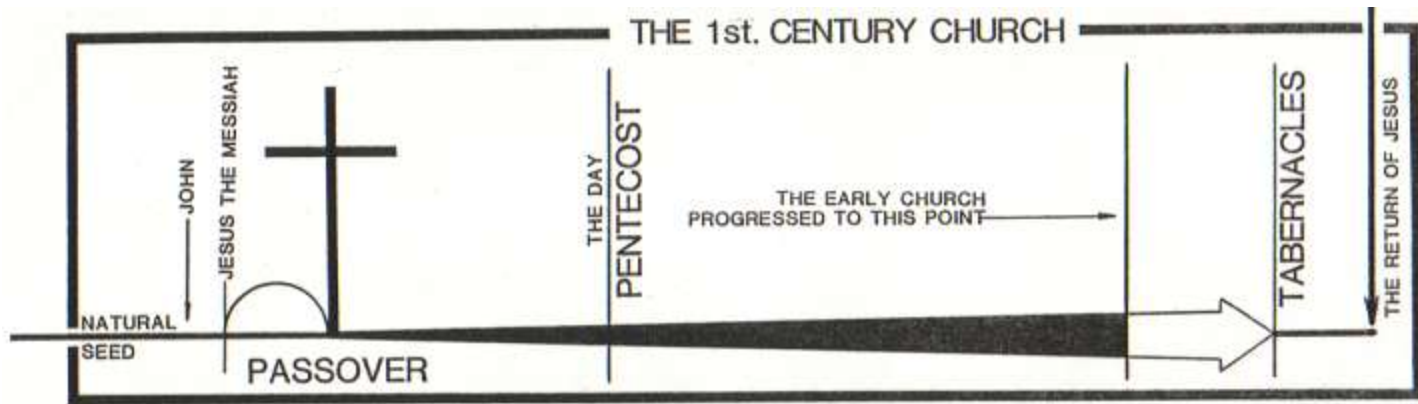

This is the first of three patterns that overlay each other

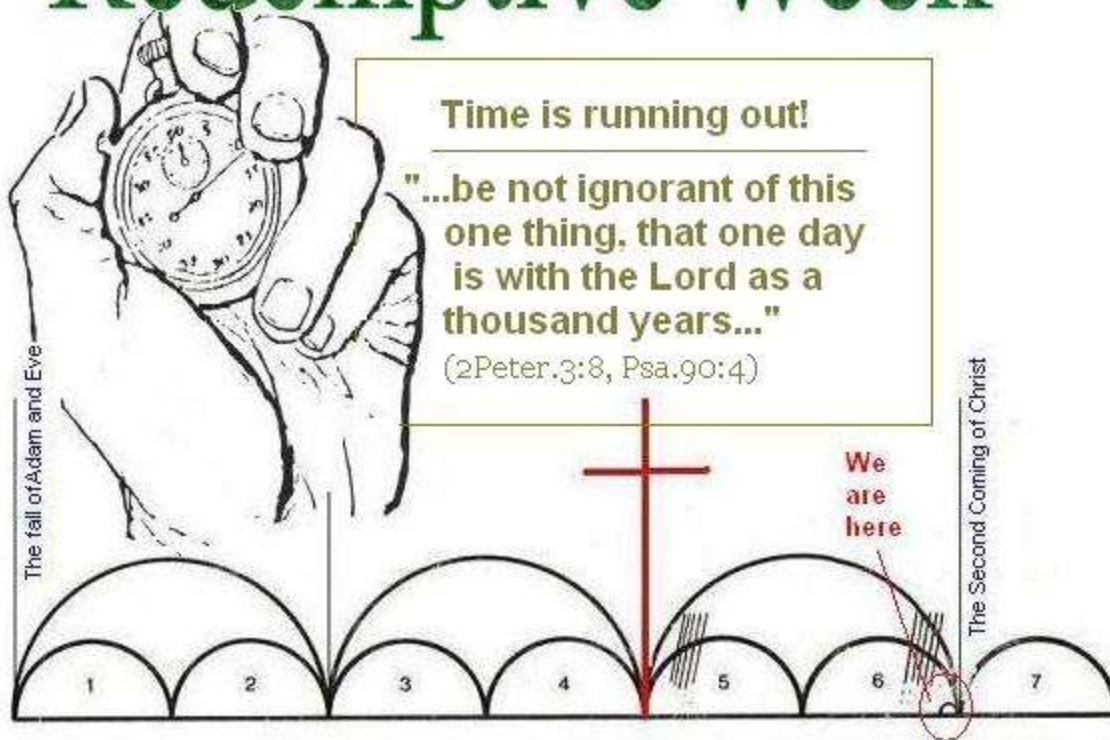
confirming that God is working according to a deliberate plan and purpose. (The other two are, Phase 4, The Tabernacle of Moses, and

Phase 8, 9, 11 The Feasts of Israel).

Redemptive Week



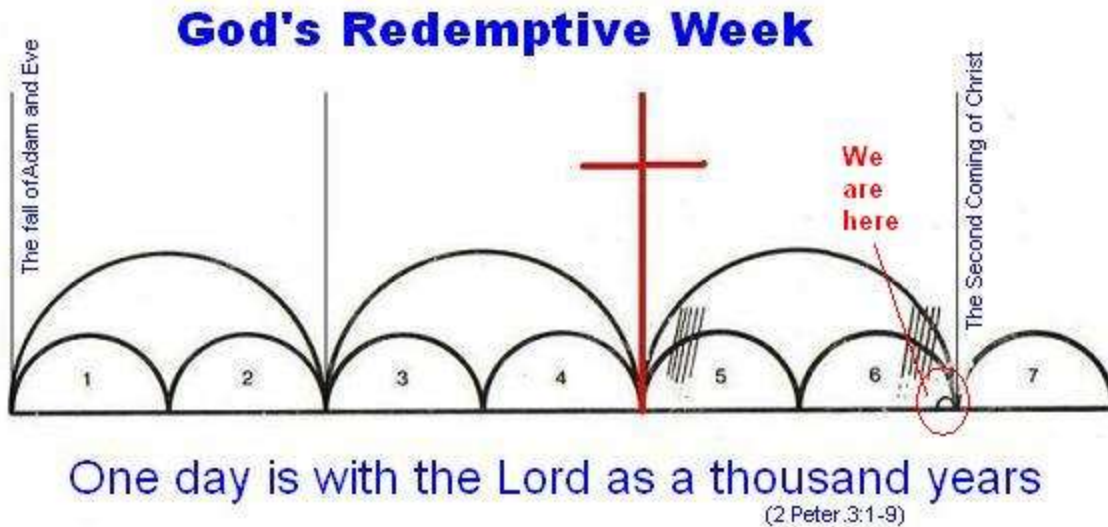
Phase 3 - Redemptive

Week

This Phase teaches **the time frame that God is working within, to make Eve (the Bride Church)**. God always works in patterns of "**weeks**" or "sevens" (Gen.1-2, Exod.16:26, Lev.23; 25:1-7) Therefore it is not a strange thing that He would work six days and rest the seventh in His Redemptive plan for man (mankind, humanity) to be the Bride of Christ. **These Redemptive days are** interpreted by the apostle Peter to be **1000 year days**. (2 Peter.3:1-9, Psalm.90:4)

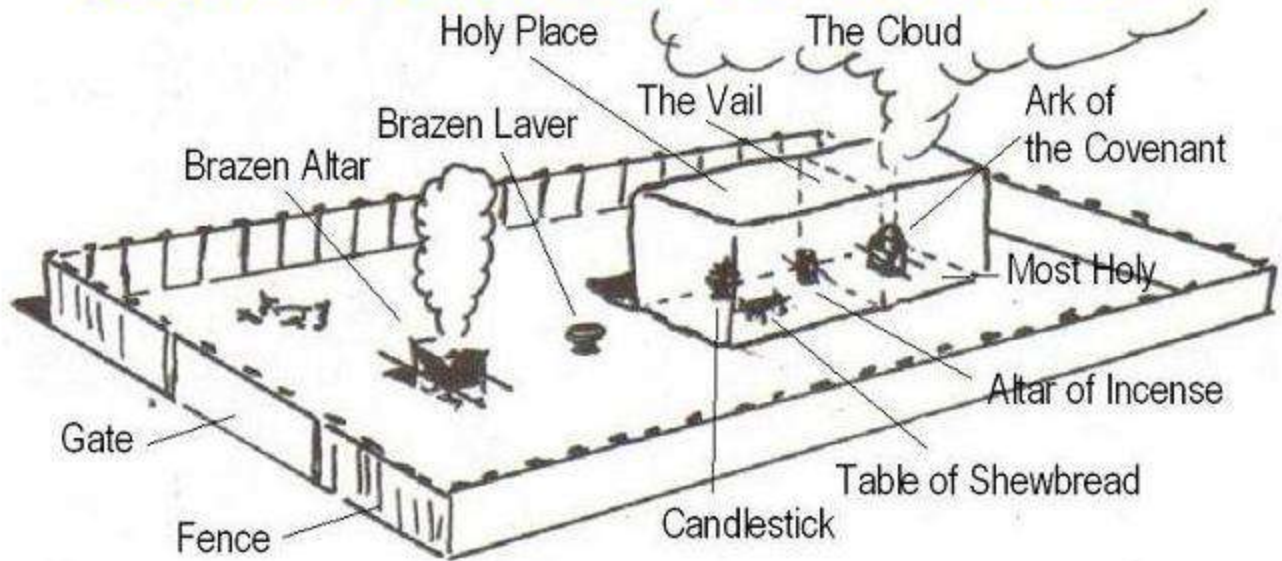
History confirms this by the study of the "begats" of Genesis 5:1-32. They reveal that there are approximately 2,000 years(2 Redemptive days) from Adam to Abraham. Abraham to Christ can be chronicled to be another 2,000 years (2 Redemptive days), which gives 4,000 years from Adam to Christ. (4 days) Now it is understood why

Israel was to keep the Passover Lamb (which foreshadows Christ - 1 Cor.5:7-8) for 4 days before killing it in the evening. (Exod.12:1-6) When Adam sinned, Christ our Passover was taken and kept 4,000 years (4 days) and crucified at the end (*i.e.* the evening) of the fourth day. Our calendar (which not accurate) places us 2,000 years AD. (another 2 days) completing almost 6,000 years since Adam, or 6days before the Lord. Now apply the pattern that God stops working after six days, and rests the seventh. (Gen.2:1-2)



Note: Jesus will NOT return until the mystery of God is finished, (Rev.10:7, Acts.3:21) which coincides with the end of the sixth day. Then there is a 1000 year rest, the ultimate Sabbath. The seventh day! (Rev.20:5) Time is running out! The Bride is about to be completed! **Note: This study IS NOT saying** that Jesus is returning at the year 2,000 AD. because obviously He did not. However, it does give a picture of the urgency of the hour. One thing is for sure, our generation, is the closest yet to the Marriage of Christ and His Church.

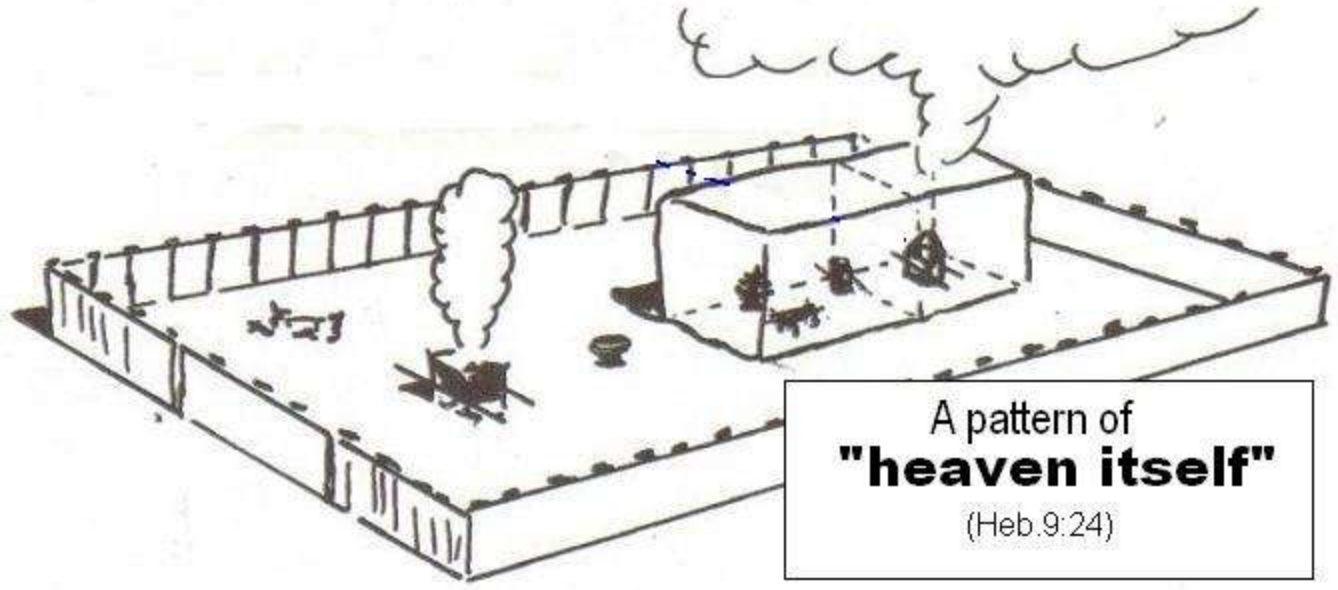
Tabernacle of Moses



Phase 4 -

Tabernacle of Moses

The Tabernacle of Moses confirms that the Spirit of God is leading (John.16:12-13) the Church (Bride) according to the same pattern revealed in Israel's journey from Egypt to the promised land. (Note: The chart above) This is the second witness. (Deut.19:15, Matt.18:16, 2 Cor.13:1)



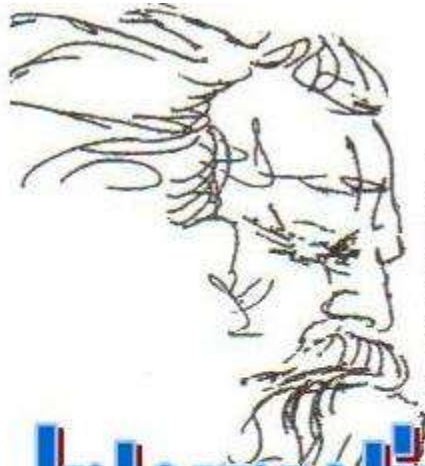
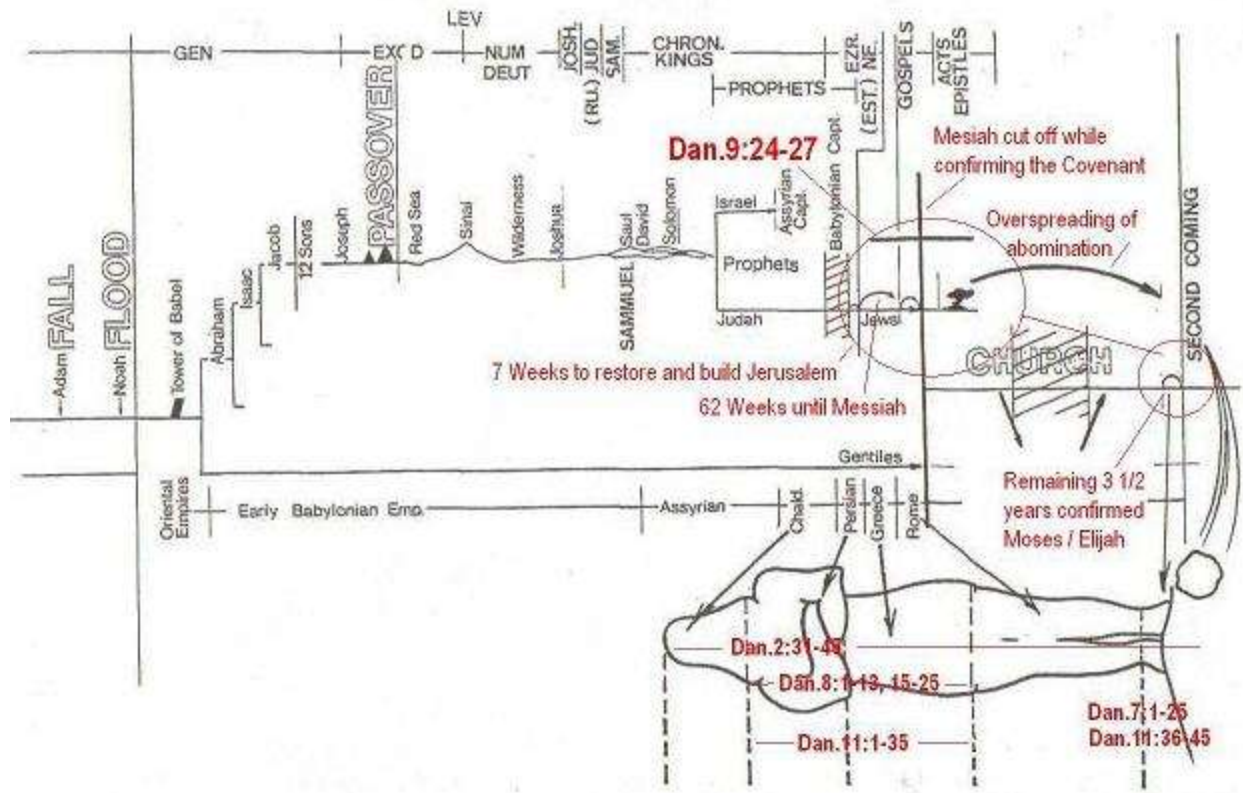
When Moses was about to make the Tabernacle, God reminded him many times to **"make all things according to the pattern shewed to thee on the mount."** (Heb.8:5, Exod.25:9,40) **The reason for this** is because it is a pattern of "heaven itself" (Heb.8:5; 9:24) This pattern is given by "inspiration of God and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness: That the man (Grk.- a human being - *Strong's*) of God may be perfect, through furnished" and prepared as the Bride of Christ. (2 Tim.3:16-17, Eph.4:11-16)



Phase 5 - *Daniel's Visions and*

Prophecies

Daniel's visions and prophecies teaches us **the balance between the Church being the Bride of Christ and why God's hand is still upon the Jews today.** He has not finished "confirming" the Covenant (Dan.9:27, Gal.3:17, John.1:11) to the "father's," (Rom.11:28 Abraham, Isaac and Jacob) "the children after their flesh." (Rom.9:1-8) Israel (the children of the flesh of Abraham) are **part of the purpose of God, which is the Church, the Bride of Christ.** (Eph.3:1-12)



"all the prophets from Samuel and those that follow after, (Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Daniel, Hosea, Joel, Amos, Obadiah, Jonah, Micah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Haggai, Zechariah and Malachi) as many as have spoken, have likewise foretold of these days."

(Acts.3:19-24, v.24)

Interpreting the Prophets

Phase 6 -

Interpreting the Prophets

God's Redemptive purpose has unfolded as each book of the Bible is read from Genesis through to the book of Acts and the Epistles. After this there appears to be a gap, until the last day and the Book of Revelation. **There is no gap!** The apostle Peter declared that "all **the prophets** from Samuel and those that follow after... have likewise **foretold of these days**," (the "apparent gap.") (Acts.2:16-36; 3:18-25) This makes the **language** of the Prophets, crucial in understanding our present day, because they have already prophesied about the decline and restoration of the Church to be the Bride.

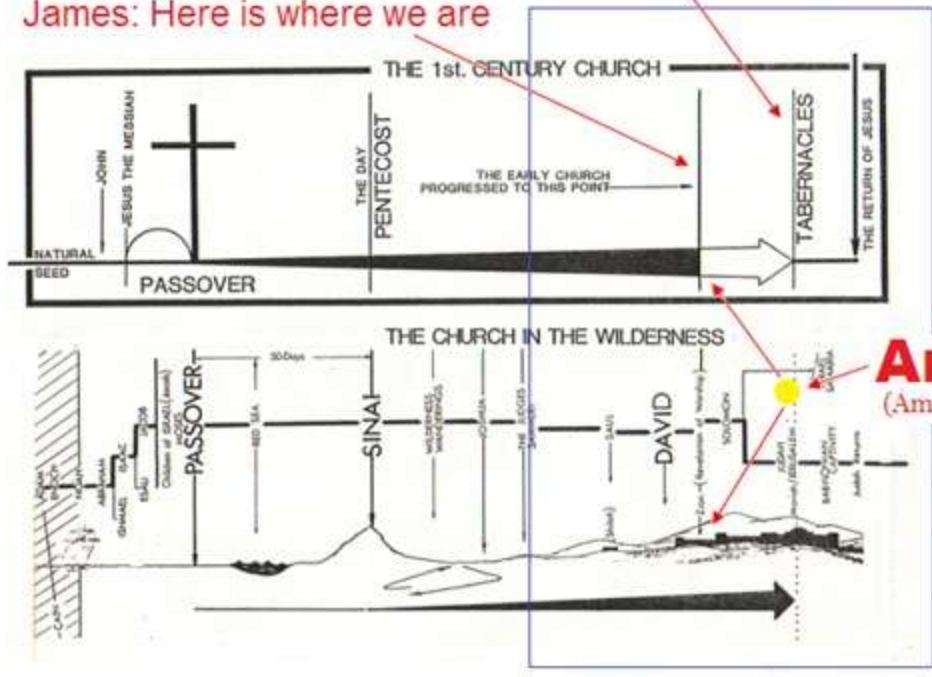
However when the Prophets spoke, they spoke of the Tabernacle of Moses, Levitical priesthood, Feast days, Five offerings, Divers washings and ordinances, and the journey of Israel from Egypt to the Promised Land. How does this relate to the New Testament Church? This is answered by the apostle Paul, the "wise master builder" (architect, the reader of blueprints). **Paul interprets this language to be "types" and "shadows,"** (1 Cor.10:1-11, Rom.15:4) **that brings "us to Christ,"**(Gal.3:24, Matt.5:17-19, Heb.9:1-26) **the Bridegroom.** (Note: Rom.16:25-26, Acts.28:23 / Luke.24:1-45. Acts.1:3) To misread the prophets, is to miss what "the Spirit saith unto the Churches." This study provides a pattern that anyone can apply to determine who the prophet is speaking to.

Phase 7 - *The Tabernacle of*

David

This phase **teaches** us where the early, first century Church attained to in their **preparation as the Bride of Christ.** (Acts.15:1-16) A prophetic picture of where the Church is today.



Phase 8 - *The Feast of*

Passover

This phase of the blueprint teaches **the beginning of the calendar for the Bride.** The feast day of Passover is a "shadow of things to come" or **the one foreshadowed is Christ.**"(Col.2:16-17, 1 Cor.5:7-8) **Passover** was the **beginning of the year** for the "church in the wilderness." (Exod.12:1-2, Acts.7:38) Christ offering Himself as the Passover was the beginning for the Church, and it is our beginning as we are "born again." This was when Israel came out of Egypt as "a peculiar treasure ...and...a kingdom of priests, and a holy nation." (Exod.19:1-6) The same is true for the believer in

Christ. (1 Peter.2:5-9, Rev.1:6; 5:10) When we receive Christ, we are "penciled in" (so-to-speak) on God's calendar to be part of His Bride. I say "penciled" in because we have to make ourselves ready, (Rev.19:7) out of obedience to God's Word.



Phase 9 -

The Feast of Pentecost

The Feast of Pentecost adds to the calendar for the Bride of Christ. This feast was celebrated 50 days after the Feast of Passover. (Lev.23:15-22) This was the third month in Israel's calendar. It was **fulfilled** on the "day of Pentecost" as the Feast of Pentecost was occurring, fifty days after Passover - Grk. (Acts.2:1-17) **on the same**, just as Passover was **fulfilled on the same day** as the actual Feast of Passover was being celebrated. God is confirming that He will abide by His calendar that was foreshadowed by the Church in the wilderness.

Note: There was yet another Feast to be celebrated in Israel's calendar, the [Feast of Tabernacles](#) . However the early first century Church never experienced the fulfillment

of this Feast. By about 100 AD? [they began to spiritually decline](#) and lost all the truth that the Holy Ghost had lead (John.16:12-13) them into. This ended in the "dark ages" (500 AD.) and lasted for about a 1000 years. This darkness was broken by Martin Luther and the Reformation. (1517 AD.) and God's calendar of the Feasts was begun again with the Christ our Passover. (1Cor.5:7-8) Three hundred years later (1800 AD.?) this was followed by Water Baptism by immersion. (This parallel's the Laver, Red Sea, and the feast of Unleavened Bread [Review: Phase. 2 and 4](#)). Then one hundred years after that (1906 AD.) God poured out His Spirit as He did on the day of Pentecost. (The Feast of Pentecost) For the last 100 years God has been leading the Church toward the **Feast of Tabernacles to complete His calendar for His Bride**, the Church. (The Bride the Lamb's wife - Eph.4:11-16; 5:21-33)

Remember: One day with the Lord is as a 1000 years. Therefore it has only been half a day since the Reformation. We MUST see time as God sees time.

Phase 11 - The Feast of

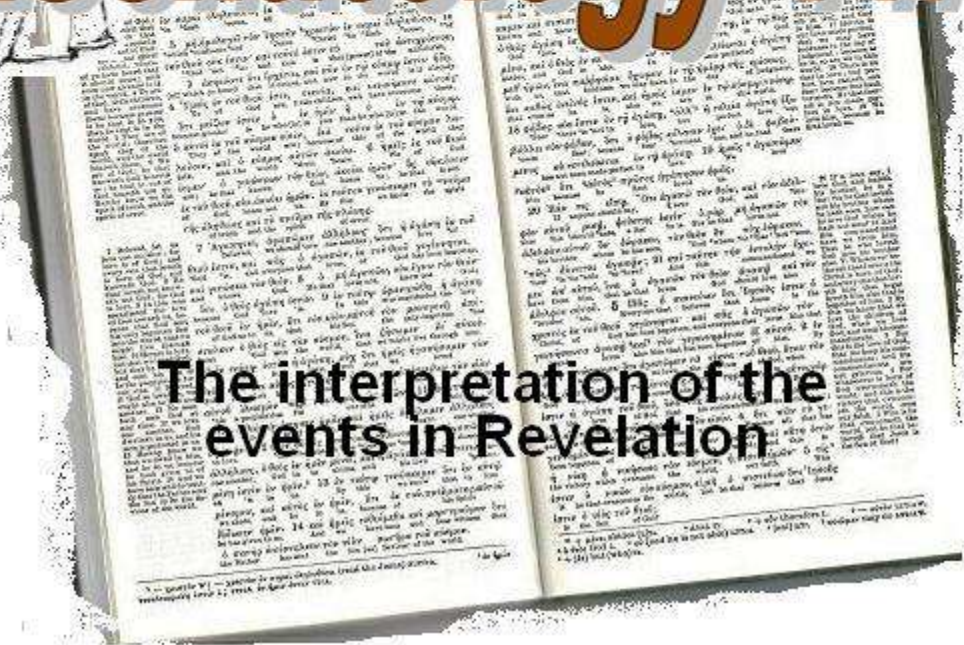
Tabernacles

Feast of Tabernacles is divided into three divisions. The Feast of Trumpets, (**which we are presently living in the fulfillment of**). The Day of Atonement (**which is not been fulfilled yet. "Things not as seen yet"- Heb.11:7, Matt.24:37**) and the Feast of Booths or Tabernacles. (**Also "things not as seen yet"- 1Cor.2:9-10, Heb.11:7, Matt.24:37**) The purpose for introducing the Feast of Tabernacles as phase eleven is because of what the angel did during the seventh seal (Rev.8:1-3). It is an **exact pattern of what Aaron, the high priest, did during the Feast of Tabernacles.** (Lev.16:12-12) **The feast that the Church is coming to!**

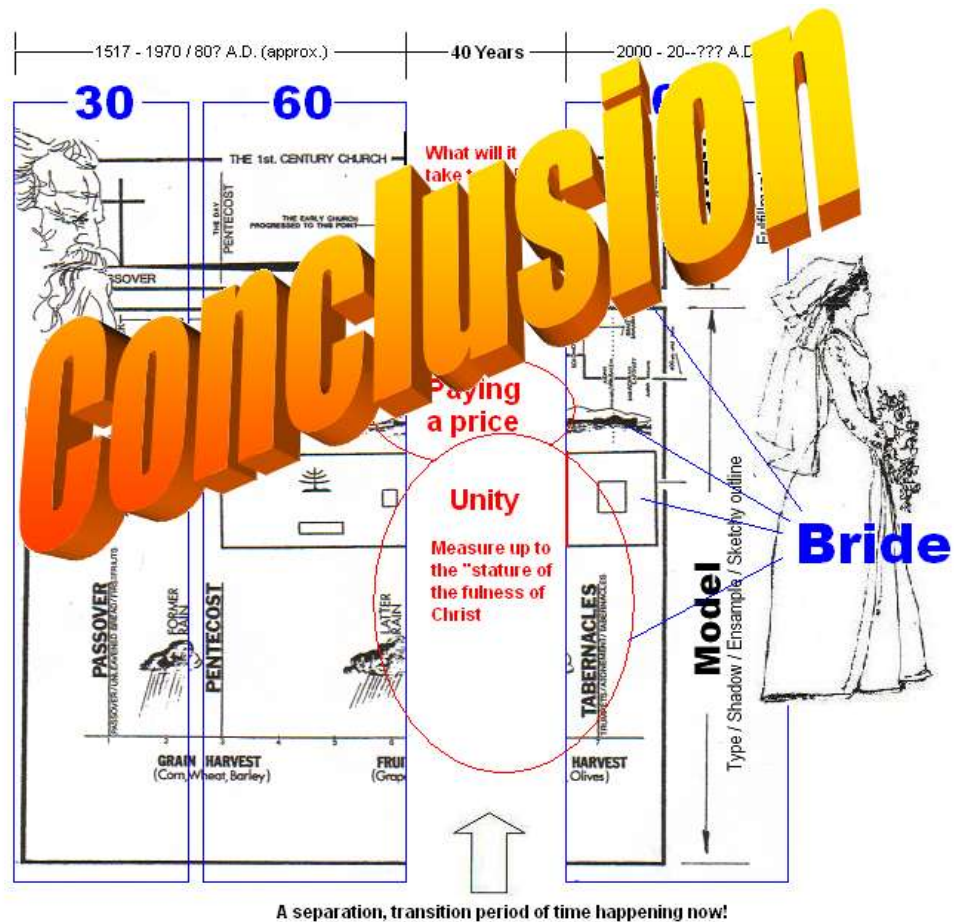


The interpretation of the events in Revelation
