As much as you would like to say that it's not your "calling," the truth remains that you have been given the responsibility of shepherding God's flock. Please keep in mind that they are HIS sheep and He has entrusted them to you.

What will it take for you to say 'enough is enough?' If "men of God" remain silent at a time like this, who then shall we expect to speak up for the lost souls of men? Why should we expect a Christian to care about the murdering of a soul when our pastors are so indifferent about it? For God's sake, open your mouth, literally! Pastors who remain silent and fail to lead the charge to defend these lost souls of men blindly heading for hell are surely an abomination to God.

Speaking about the suicide of a soul or murdering the soul does not placate God's anger over this travesty. I can assure you that supporting "silence" will never win you favor with the Lord. What has become of our pulpits in America today? He was sitting in judgment of their wrong doing. Today our Saviour is presented as one who was meek, lowly, kind, and loving, even to false teachers, but this is entirely false. When dealing with false teachers, and prophets, His words were Sharp and His actions plain. Jesus said to the religious Pharisees, "O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh," Matt 12:34. Jesus stood face to face with these false teachers and called them "hypocrites," "blind guides," "blind," "whited sepulchers," "serpents," and "ye generation of vipers" Matt; 23:23-34. Yet today, so-called Bible believing preachers and Christians insist on working with all these assorted heretics and telling their congregations that we worship the same God. Lying blood sucking vermin! Peter said it plainly,

*"But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction" 2 Peter 2:1.*

Sharing the Gospel and protecting the souls of men should be the foremost goal of your church. The Devil is seeking to devour God's children. The war is real and real lives are being lost. Sticking your head in the sand will not make you less accountable to a holy and righteous God. God is not impressed by the size of your ministry. He doesn't care how adept you are at juggling programs or how

many old folks you visited in the nursing home. You will stand naked and defenseless before Him for your apathy toward His children. Jesus warned us in Matthew 19:

*"Suffer little children, and forbid them not, to come unto me: for of such is the kingdom of heaven."* Matthew 19:14

Matthew 18:14 says, *"Even so it is not the will of your Father which is in heaven, that one of these little ones should perish."* Matthew 18:14

**God gives stern warnings about adding to His Word.**

Proverbs 30:6 says, "Add thou not unto His words, lest He reprove thee, and thou be found a liar." Revelation 22:17-19 also gives a stern warning to the one who would add or subtract from the plan of salvation.

**To pervert the gospel message is to bring a curse upon the preacher of it.**

"But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed (Galatians 1:8)."

**Altering the message will make it a message that will not save, the cross of Christ will be made of none effect.**

I Corinthians 1:17 says that we are to, "...preach the gospel: not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of none effect."

**To tamper with God's message of salvation is to call God a liar.**

I John 5:10-11 says, "...He that believeth not God hath made him a liar: because he believeth not the record that God gave of His Son. And this is the record that God hath given to us eternal life, and this life is in His Son."

**A poison laced message makes man's righteousness a part of salvation.**

Man's righteousness is filthy rags according to Isaiah 64:6 and would pollute the salvation of God. Romans 10:3, says "For they being ignorant of God's righteousness, and going about to establish their own righteousness, have not submitted unto the righteousness of God."

**The poison laced message causes the saved to become confused.**

It robs them of their assurance and brings them into bondage thinking they must do something to stay saved. This is what happened at the churches of Galatia. "And that because of false brethren unawares brought in, who came privily to spy out our liberty which we have in Christ Jesus, that they might bring us into bondage" Galatians 2:4.

**The poison laced message causes the lost to be blinded.**

Satan doesn't want the lost to hear the true gospel message. The perverted message hides the true message. "But if our gospel be hid, it is hid to them that are lost: In whom the god of this world (Satan) hath blinded the minds of them which believe not..." II Corinthians 4:3-4."

**The poison laced message keeps the Christian from a clear witness.**

"Seeing then that we have such hope, we use great plainness of speech" II Corinthians 3:12.

**The poison laced message makes the world think that salvation is by works.**

"But Peter said unto him, Thy money perish with thee, because thou hast thought that the gift of God may be purchased with money" Acts 8:20.

**The poison laced message brings persecution to those who preach grace.**

Paul said that if he preached a "poison laced gospel" he would not be persecuted. Galatians 5:11 says, "And I, brethren, if I yet preach circumcision (works), why do I yet suffer persecution: then is the offence of the cross ceased."

Be alert! Be on guard for this perversion of the gospel of Jesus Christ. The beauty of the true message is its simplicity! Let's continue to proclaim it loud and clear!
