

# **The King James Bible Is the Very Words of God**

Fundamentalists believe that God gave His precious Word by divine inspiration in the original manuscripts, and lost it in translation. If that were so Jesus Christ could be considered a sinner, and He’s not! He did not use the originals; He used a copy as did Paul and the Apostles. They did not have the originals! They only had copies in the first generation not the originals. Many fundamentalists today do not believe that God can preserve what He originally gave. What fools they are to say that God could not preserve His Word. Since He Spoke His creation into existence! Just look around you in awe at this magnificent universe and all of this came into being from His Spoken Word and then for them to say and believe He could not preserve His Word. When you see the word "preservation", you are immediately referring to the authorized King James Version which is the true translation. The revisers and the paraphraser’s who have

butchered up the Word of God in publishing the RSV, the MV, the NASV, NIV, ESV, the NEV, Good News for Modern Man, the NKJV and scores of other revisions and paraphrases certainly could most assuredly not lay claim to "preservation".

Bible believers know we have the inerrant, preserved Words of God; inerrancy demands preservation! The reason we have the perfect revelation of God in the original manuscripts and now in the King James Version is that God moved upon holy men, turning their minds into His workshop and perfecting the recording of His Holy Word, thus giving it to us by His sovereign, supernatural work of grace apart of any involvement of man, except writing it down, it being His divine action alone.

It was later translated out of the original languages by brilliant, godly men, who were the doctors of biblical literature in their day and by no means perfect men.
