And fifty pedophiles lost their lives in Orlando, Florida at a night club for Sodomites. It made Orlando a little safer as a city. The downside, it's a shame that more of them were not gunned down because those left will still go on molesting, raping, killing and perverting Orlando's children. God has "given that crowd up" Rom. 1:26 and "turned them over to reprobate minds" Rom. 1:28. God condemns that vile lifestyle and calls it an abomination. God's judgments are "remedial" and "dreadful." God uses remedial judgments to bring a nation to repentance and when that fails Him, He uses "dread release" to destroy that nation. He releases dreadful destruction upon that nation, until they are no more, Sodom and Gomorrah. A just government would never allow what's going on in this country to go on. A just government should put sodomites to death!

WARNING, this is a message of warning! America is a sinful nation that is currently experiencing the judgment of God. God has raised up many prophetic voices to call America back to repentance and to warn that continued rebellion will lead to doom. America has refused to listen to these prophets. Instead, the nation has stiffened in its rebellion against God. The result is that America has passed the point of no return, the point of "dread release," when God delivers a nation from judgment to destruction. And thus, the wrath of God is about to fall on this nation, most likely in the form of an economic collapse from which there will be no recovery and then some believe that He will use nuclear fusion to destroy us. Even now, this very day, Great Britain has voted to come out of the EU, just as prophesied in Scripture over three-thousand years ago. America's people's only hope is Jesus Christ. Over half of the people in the United States voted to legalize homosexuality and recently the Supreme Court legalized same-sex marriage. This I believe was the final straw that tipped the scale for the total collapse of the US economy and its ultimate destruction. Make no mistake the sudden death of Anthony Scalia, Supreme Court Justice has turned the tide and will bring it on.

And then I'm sure it's also going to be used to push an agenda against so-called "hate speech." So Bible-believing Christian preachers who preach what the Bible actually says about homosexuality, that it's vile, that it's disgusting, that they're reprobates, you know, we're going to be blamed. Like, "It's all extremism! It's not just the Muslims, it's the Christians!" I'm sure that that's coming. I'm sure that people are going to start attacking, you know, Bible-believing Christians now, because of what this guy did.

Now let me just be real clear: I've never advocated for violence. I don't believe in, you know, taking the law into our own hands. I would never go in and shoot up a gay night club, so-called. I don't believe it's right for us to just be a vigilante. But I will say this: The Bible says that homosexuals should be put to death, in Leviticus 20:13. Obviously, it's not right for somebody to just, you know, shoot up the place because that's not going through the proper channels. But these people all should have been killed, anyway, but they should have been killed through the proper channels, as in they should have been executed by a righteous government that would have tried them, convicted them, and saw them executed. Because, in Leviticus 20:13, God's perfect law, he put the death penalty on murder, and he also put the death penalty on homosexuality. That's what the Bible says, plain and simple.

"...Vengeance is mine; I will repay, saith the Lord." Rom. 12:19

I'm not sorry for what the Bible says nor am I heartbroken about the shooting there in Orlando. I'm not going to cry about their deaths either. Because these 50 people in that gay gathering club that got shot, they were going to die of AIDS, and syphilis, and whatever else. They were all going to die early, anyway, because homosexuals have a 20-year shorter life-span than normal people.

It is an ill-omened message of truth that Americans, even Christians, will rebel against. The Christian community and will reject it because it has compromised its values with the world, it has wrapped itself in the flag of patriotism, and it has deceived itself with its Hollywood gospel of health, wealth and prosperity.

When God sent prophets to Israel and Judah, calling them to repentance, the people mocked the prophets. "We are God's Chosen People," they reminded the prophets. "God will never allow our nation to be destroyed" Jeremiah 5:12-13 and Micah 3:11.

For the past hundred years, God has been raising up prophetic voices in America voices like Dr. Peter S. Ruckman calling this country to repentance. We have reacted in the same manner as the ancient Israelites. We have mocked the prophets by arrogantly reminding them that we are a “Christian nation.”

But the truth is that we are anything but a Christian nation. Our behavior as a nation makes a mockery of Christianity. We lead the world in every abomination known to man, abortion, alcoholism, drug addiction, gambling, divorce, child abuse, violent crime, sodomy, same-sex perversion, bestiality, pornography, and yes, even child pornography. Worse yet, we export our violence and immorality to other countries through our sleazy movies and television programs. We have become the moral polluter of planet earth.

And we are reaping what we have sown. The judgment of God is upon this nation. Read Deuteronomy 28:15-48. The curses of a nation under judgment are listed there. The passage reads like a detailed description of American society cities in chaos, youth in bondage, government corruption and confusion, a foreign policy in retreat, rampant disease, epidemic divorce, agricultural calamity, catastrophic storms, tornados, floods and increasing foreign influence in domestic programs.

Yet, despite these judgments, we have refused to repent. In fact, we have stiffened in our rebellion against God. In our schools, we have abolished prayer, removed the Ten Commandments, and banned the distribution of Bibles. We have terrorized our teachers into believing they will lose their jobs if they mention God to their students. We have even mandated the teaching of atheistic evolution and have prohibited the truth of creationism.

We have recently legalized and even encouraging sodomy teaching it in our schools from kinder garden and up. Transgenderism was just recently made legal in the military. What has to happen to America? We are handing out condoms and needles to our youth. We are going out of our way to protect every expression of profanity and obscenity. Our state governments are encouraging immorality by promoting gambling in every conceivable form. And our artists are wallowing in blasphemy, using every form of artistic expression to mock and ridicule God. Praying in the name of Jesus is forbidden.

America is thumbing its nose at God. The Supreme Court is in rebellion against God. Our Congress is hardened against God. Our Bureaucracy could care less about God. Our educational system has banned God. America is ripe for total annihilation. Again, how will God’s wrath be manifested toward us? Initially, it is most likely to come in the form of an economic collapse from which there will be no hope of recovery. Ultimately, it is likely to be consummated in our destruction by nuclear weapons.

As we face the consequences of America’s war against God, let those of us who are Christians do so with hope in our hearts, remembering the words of Nahum 1:7

“The Lord is good. He is a stronghold in the day of trouble. And He knows those who take refuge in Him.”

"Pardon me," said the scholar, "the sentiment was delivered about 400 years ago;" Complaining about the times it would be hard to discover, for complaining does not mend them.
